Royal Stable – Königlicher Pferdestall

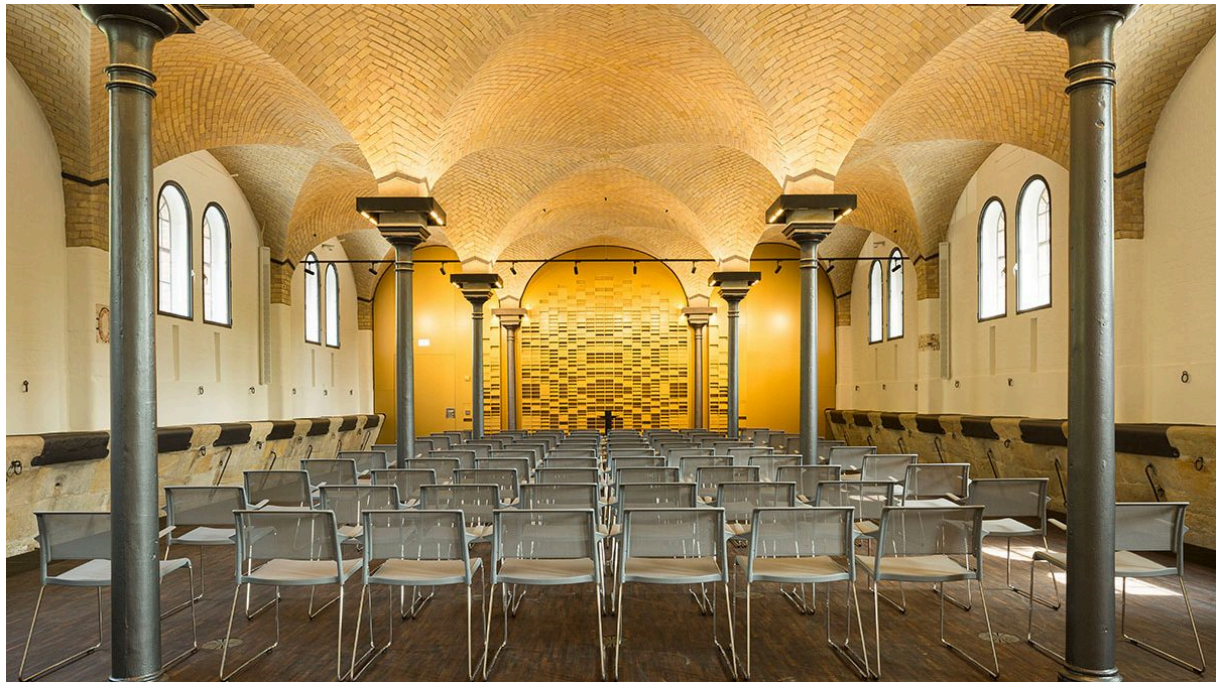

The Royal Stable is a prominent communication and cultural centre at Leibniz University Hannover dedicated to hosting a wide array of scientific and cultural events. These include informative lectures, engaging seminars, large-scale conferences, critical examinations, memorable graduation ceremonies, and various cultural activities that enrich the campus community. Rooms within the facility are exclusively reserved for internal university use, ensuring a focused environment conducive to academic and cultural exchange, and fostering collaboration among students, faculty, and esteemed guests. The East Wing, featuring a banquet hall and seminar spaces, was inaugurated on 22 May 2019 by University President Prof. Dr Volker Epping and Prof. Dr-Ing. Erich Barke. The renovation by Haberland Architekten, Berlin, received the „Best Architects Award.“ The listed red-brick building was constructed between 1885 and 1888 at Appelstraße 7 (formerly Militärstraße) for the 1st Hanoverian Uhlán Regiment No. 13. It was designed by Eduard Schuster and Karl Friedrich Heinrich Habbe. After its military use, the two-storey structure (12.5m x 77m) was transferred to the Polytechnic School of Hannover, now

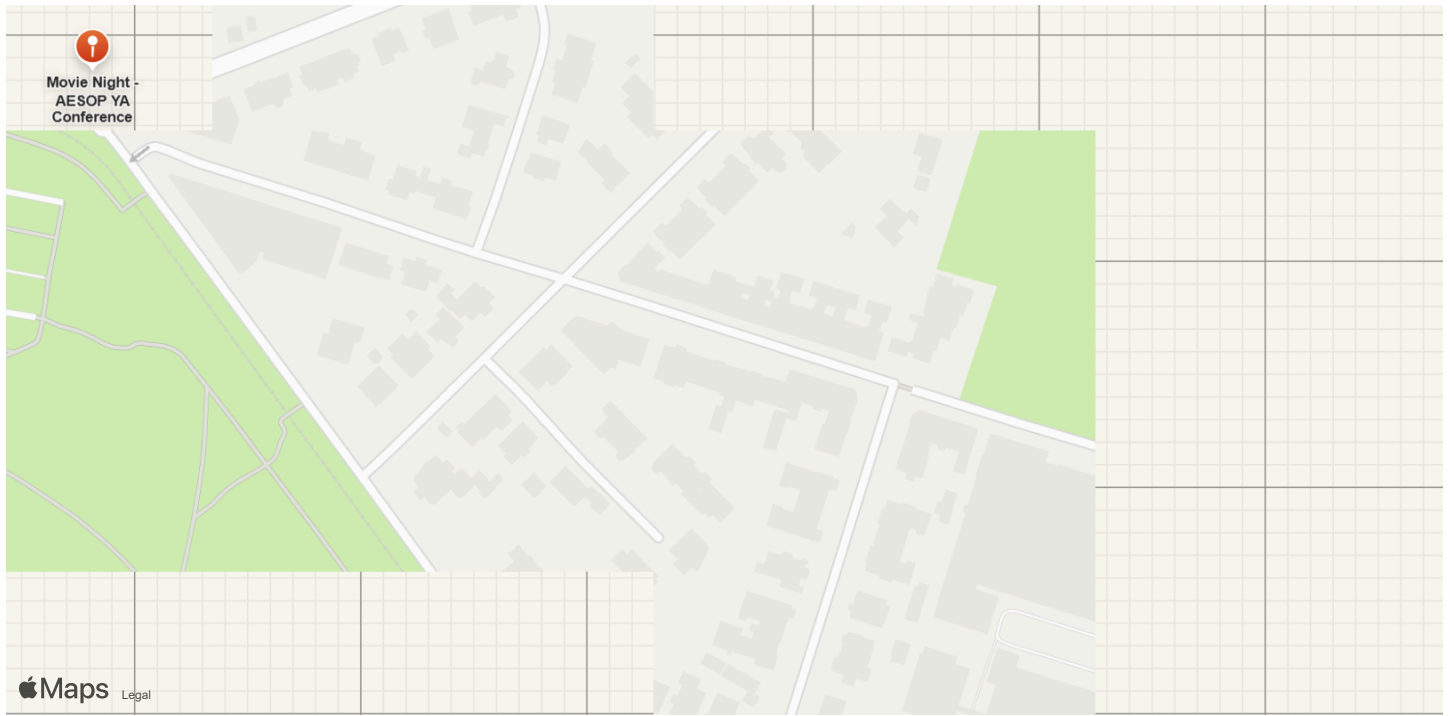
Leibniz University, and repurposed as a research, teaching, and institutional building. Former University President Prof. Dr-Ing. Erich Barke initiated the renovation project, raising €2 million in donations and sponsorships by 2019. An additional €2 million was funded by the university for building maintenance.
