Accommodation

Participants have possibilities to be accommodated in very good hotels that offers prices from 50/60 € per night (several of them are located 300 to 500 m from UBT).

Public transportation is available by public buses and taxi.

The average cost for participants for hotel, meals, transport will be 80-100 € per day.
